Nizamabad Centenary fest yet to take off

Nizamabad, Nov 2: The district that received state-wide recognition for cultural integration through the Indur (Nizamabad) Utsav is getting set to celebrate centenary of its formation.

The then Collector Asok Kumar organized the Indur Festival involving people from all sections of society from 2001 to 2003.
