# Post-Matric Scholarships

- (i) **Maintenance Fees:** The Maintenance Fees (MTF) is sanctioned to BC students and credited online into their account. The annual income of parent's should not exceed **Rs.1.50 lakh** in Rural Area and **Rs.2.00 lakhs** in Urban Areas.

There are **four** types of **MTF** scholarships.

- **Department Attached Hostels (DAH),**
- **College Attached Hostels (CAH),**
- **Student Managed Hostels (SMH) and**
- **Day Scholars (DS).**

The rates of Scholarship vary according to the category

## ii) RTF

The Reimbursement of Tution Fees (RTF) is released to the account of Principals of Education Institution of the eligible BC students

All students register online in the e-pass website of Telangana Government.

# **MAHATMA JYOTHIBA PHULE BC OVERSEAS VIDYA NIDHI**

- For BCs Started from 1 April 2016, for EBCs from 1 April 2017
- For eligible graduates to pursue Post Graduate/Ph.D studies,
  - In universities in USA, UK, Australia, Canada, Singapore, Germany, New Zealand, Japan, France and South Korea
  - With Minimum of 60% marks in graduation exams and minimum prescribed scores in ToEFL / IELTS/ GRE/ GMAT/PTE
  - Having age less than 35 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> July and
  - With family income less than Rs 5.00 Lakhs per annum
  - 5% of 300 students reserved for EBCs
  - Assistance for only One child in a family

# Starting of 119 new Residential Schools

- On 12<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2017, **119** Residential Schools ( **56 for Boys, 63 for Girls**) were started @1 per assembly constituency.
- **30,500** students newly admitted in the schools
- All infrastructure facilities- Furniture, Dual Desks, Dining tables, Utensils, bunker beds, boards etc were provided to every School.
- This is the **FIRST TIME IN THE COUNTRY** where so many Residential Schools were started on a Single day
- Total students in institutions : 41863 students
